Substantial Changes to the Course Dates

Changes of Start Dates or Schedule by NWSWB

NWSWB reserves the right to cancel or reschedule a course or program due to low enrollment or other causes. If the NWSWB cancels or reschedules a course, or the class starting date is amended by 21 days or more, STUDENT will be notified of such an event in writing 30 days prior to such change and is entitled to a refund of all tuition paid unless such changes are agreed upon in writing by the STUDENT.

Refund Policy

1. If training is terminated after the STUDENT enters classes the school will retain a percentage of the total tuition due to the school based on the Refund Schedule below.
2. Any refunds due will be paid within 30 days from the last date of attendance or within 30 days from the date of receipt of written or verbal notification of cancellation.

Refund Schedule

Up to and including the 1 st day of attending class	0% Tuition Retained
Attending the 2 nd -6 th days of class	50% Tuition Retained
Attending 7 or more days of class	100% Tuition Retained

Tuition Payments

A deposit of \$100.00 per course must accompany this signed enrollment agreement. Payment of this deposit reserves the STUDENT's enrollment in the selected courses. The remaining tuition amount due of \$495 per course, must be paid 2 weeks prior to the course beginning. The \$100.00 deposit may be paid by check, cash, money order, MasterCard or Visa. The NWSWB reserves the right to adjust tuition rates once a year if required, which adjusted rates will become effective at the beginning of the fall quarter.
